CATHERINE O'CONNELL

Was the 2nd dau. of the Liberator, and was *b.* in 1808; she *d.* 19 April, 1891, having *m.* her kinsman, Charles O'Connell, senior, representative of the Ballinablown branch, deriving from Charles O'Connell, mentioned in the will of his brother, John O'Connell, of Ashtown, 17 Jan. 1680. An elder brother, Daniel, (will 20 Oct. 1683), was the ancestor of the Darrynane Branch, through John (the eldest son of said Daniel) mentioned in both wills, who petitioned the Court of Claims, 2 Aug. 1700. Charles O'Connell, *b.* 12 Aug. 1805, and *d.* 20 Jan. 1877, was M.P. for co. Kerry. He was the eldest son of Daniel O'Connell, of Ballinablown, and Theresa Lombard, his wife. They had,
