- G3K Therese Gertrude Downes, *b.* 1879; *d.* 1944; *m.* 7 Jan. 1906, Maurice Joseph Fitzgerald, of Kinneagh House, *b.* 1875; *d.* Nov. 1939. They have four children and five grandchildren, but as Mr. Fitzgerald is shown below at F3A, being the great grandson of the Liberator through his mother, Mary O'Connell French, and his grandmother, Elizabeth Mary O'Connell Mrs. French, these descendants are more properly shown below.

F1 ELIZABETH O'CONNELL

- Elizabeth Mary O'Connell ("Bessie") was the youngest dau. to reach maturity of the Liberator, *b.* 1810; *d.* 1893 at Kinneagh. There is a memorial inscription to her at the chapel, Darrynane Abbey. She *m.* in 1831, Nicholas Joseph French, nephew of Edmund French, Bishop of Galway, formerly of Fort William and afterwards of Frenchlawn, both in co. Roscommon, a Resident Magistrate, *b.* —; *d.* 1841. They had,

He was the son of Edward Fitzgerald, of Kinneagh, by Alice, dau., and eventually heiress, of William Hayes, who had married Mary O'Connell, sister of the Baron Moritz O'Connell, and sister of Alice O'Connell, who *m.* Charles Philip O'Connell, and was mother of Sir Maurice Charles Philip O'Connell, K.C.H. Edward Fitzgerald's father, Daniel Fitzgerald, *m.* Emily Hickson, of the Grove, Dingle. David's father, another Edward, *m.* Catherine O'Connell, sister of Geoffry O'Connell, Sheara na moe moic, *d.* 1722. Mary O'C. French and John Francis Fitzgerald, of Kinneagh, had twelve children,
- F3A Maurice Joseph Fitzgerald, of Kinneagh, *b.* 1875; educated St. Edmund's, Warc, and Oscott, matriculated London University, 1892; he *m.* 9 Jan. 1906, Theresa Mary Downes, 9th grand-daughter of the Liberator (see G3K above), they had,
- F4A Maurice Benedict Fitzgerald, *b.* 28 Nov. 1906; killed in a motor accident 23 Nov. 1929; *unm.*
