

DANIEL O'CONNELL, Q.C., M.P.

He was *b.* at Carhen House, near Cahirciveen, on 6 Aug. 1775. He *m.* his third cousin once removed, Mary, dau. of Thomas O'Connell, of Ballymacprior and Tralee. The marriage took place, privately, at the house of her brother-in-law, James O'Connor, in Dame Street, Dublin, on 23 June, 1802. He *d.* on Saturday, 15 May, 1847, at the Hotel Feder, Via della Fontana 15, Genoa, and is buried, his body in Glasnevin, and his heart in the monument erected by his friend, Charles Bianconi, at the church of the Irish College at Rome. Mary, his wife, *d.* 31 Oct. 1836.

Together with a dau., Rickard, *b.* 1815, and *d.* young, they had seven children who reached maturity.

- A1 Maurice O'Connell, Esq., of Darrynane Abbey, M.P. for Tralee and Clare. who was *b.* — 1803, and who *d.* 18 Oct. 1853, at London. He *m.* at Kenmare, in 1832, Frances Bindon Scott, of Cabircon, Co. Clare. Their descendants are shown under code letter A.
- B1 Morgan O'Connell, Esq., M.P. for Co. Meath, *b.* 30 Oct. 1804; *d.* 20 Jan. 1885; *m.* on 23 July, 1840, Kate Balfe, of South Park, co. Roscommon. No issue.
- ✓ C1 John O'Connell, Esq., M.P. for Clonmel, *b.* 20 Dec. 1810; *d.* 24 May 1858; *m.*, on 28 March, 1838, Elizabeth Ryan, of Jubilee Hall, Bray, who *d.* 9 April, 1876. Their descendants are shown under code letter C.
- D1 Daniel O'Connell, M.P. for Dundalk, *b.* 22 Aug. 1816; *d.* 14 June, 1897; *m.* on 22 Oct. 1866, Ellen Mary Foster, of the Elms, Cambridge. She was *b.* on 19 Aug. 1847, and *d.* 3 March, 1913. Descendants under code letter D.
- F1 Ellen O'Connell, *b.* — 1805; *d.* 27 Jan. 1883, at Blackheath; *m.* — 1825, Christopher Fitzsimon, Esq., M.P., for co. Dublin, J.P., who was *b.* 1793, and *d.* 25 July, 1856, at Mascerata, in the Roman States. Descendants shown under code letter E.
- G1 Catherine O'Connell, *b.* — 1808; *d.* 19 April, 1891; *m.* on 7 Aug. 1832, her kinsman, Charles O'Connell, of Ballinablown, co. Kerry, M.P. for Kerry, who was *b.* on 12 Aug. 1805, and *d.* 20 Jan. 1877. Descendants shown under code letter G.
- F1 Elizabeth O'Connell, *b.* — 1810; *d.* — 1893; *m.*, in 1831 Nicholas Joseph Ffrench, previously of Fortwilliam, and latterly of Frenchlawn, co. Roscommon, who *d.* in 1841.

- Had four children who reached maturity. They were grandchildren of the Liberator, i.e. Daniel (A2A), John (A2B), Fanny (A2C), Mary (A2D).
- A2A Daniel O'Connell, *b.* 20 Nov. 1836; *d.* 30 May, 1919; late Royal Navy, retired, J.P., D.L., co. Kerry, High Sheriff, co. Kerry, 1860, architect of the church of the Immaculate Conception, Terryglass, co. Tipperary; *m.* 23 April, 1861, Isobella Shine Lawlor. She was *b.* 23 Feb. 1842, and *d.* 26 Aug. 1903, having had issue,
- A3A Isobella Mary (Sybil), *b.* 11 Aug. 1862; *d.* *unm.* 20 March, 1920, and is buried at Darrynane, which she inherited 30 May, 1919.
- A3B Kathleen, *b.* 3 March, 1869; *d.* *unm.* 8 Feb. 1940, at Darrynane; served throughout the 1914-18 war in S.S. *Delta* and Eastern Front, Q.A.I.M.N.S.
- A3C Margaret Gertrude (Peg), *b.* 14 Feb. 1874; *d.* *unm.* 8 Dec. 1933.
- A3D Eileen Mary O'Connell, of Darrynane, *m.* 28 Aug. 1933, Walter A. Heurtley, D.Litt. (Camb.), *b.* 1882, O.B.E. Mil. 1919, Silver Cross of Greek Order of the Saviour, 1924, Order of St. Sava 1931, president of Palestine Oriental Society, temporary Major (General List), author and contributor to archaeological journals. Major and Mrs. Heurtley are living at Darrynane Abbey in 1946, *s.p.*
- A3E Frances Mary (Faa), living *unm.* at Darrynane Abbey, 1946.
- A2B John Maurice O'Connell (Uncle Jack), *b.* 12 April, 1839; *d.* 1 March, 1907; *m.* 9 Aug. 1873, Mary, only dau. of Daniel McCartie, of Ardnageeha, brother of Denis McCartie, of Headfort. She *d.* 1924, having had issue,
- A3F Daniel Maurice O'Connell, *b.* 18 Sept. 1878; *d.* *unm.* 1893.
- A3G Anna O'Connell, *b.* 27 May, 1874; living, in 1946, at 121 Uxendon Hill, Wembley; she *m.* 16 Sept. 1905, James Max Kingsley, chartered accountant, and has one child,
- A4A Kathleen Kingsley, *b.* 25 June, 1911; educationist and specialist in historical subjects.
- A3H Mary O'Connell, *b.* 9 Dec. 1875; *d.* *s.p.* 16 Oct. 1936; she *m.* Captain Martyn Hooke, B.L., of the Reform Club, who was living at 20 Mount Carmel Chambers, Duke's Lane, London, on 1 Aug. 1946.
- A3I Kathleen O'Connell, Royal Red Cross, *b.* 4 May, 1877; alive in 1946, having retired from the service of the L.C.C.
- A3J Jane O'Connell, *b.* 4 Oct. 1883; *m.* 19 Feb. 1903, Timothy O'Mahoney, and living 1 Duke's Lane Chambers, Kensington, London, W.8, having had issue,
- A4B1 Denis O'Mahoney, *b.* 24 Nov. 1903; killed in R.A.F. (Lance Corporal), 12 Jan. 1932, *s.p.*
- A4B2 May O'Mahoney, *b.* 12 July, 1905 teaching in Budapesth, 1945
