- QSF Georgina Hester Cornelia Somerset, b. 17 July, 1848; d. at Colchester, 29 Jan., 1926. She m., firstly, on 4 Jan., 1872, Lionel Edmee Jobert, Comte d'Epineuil Viscomte Nautia and Baron and Seigneur de Dannemoine in Burgundy, who d.sp. 10 Oct., 1881, when she married, secondly, 15 Aug., 1894, Capt. Edward Maclean Showers, O.B.E., Chief Constable of the Essex Constabulary (b. 1850; d. 13 Dec., 1925), sp.

RAGLAN SOMERSET

- QSG Raglan Molynieux Boscawen Somerset, of Springfield Court, Chelmsford, b. 20 July, 1855. Served in Notts Constabulary, 1 Oct., 1878—31 March, 1882, and in Essex Constabulary, 1 April, 1882—31 Aug., 1915, when he had reached the substantive rank of Superintendent. From 1 July, 1883, he acted as Deputy Chief Constable of Essex.

This also completes a list of 110 of the descendants of Elizabeth's father, Sir Maurice Charles Philip O'Connell (1766—1848). It is published in the hope that readers will supply more facts and dates to make the list comprehensive.

We now turn our attention to the 3 daughters of Charles Connell Fitz Philip, the sisters of John O'Connell of Foilnagerah, and of Sir Maurice Charles Philip O'Connell. These three daughters were

As both Mary and Alicia were the ancestors of the O'Connells of Spa, Tralee, it has been found simpler to give an account of this Branch of the family in the form of an appendix.
