Ellen O'Connell was the eldest daughter of the Liberator, b. in 1805, she d. at Blackheath on 27 Jan. 1883. She m. in 1825, Christopher Fitzsimon, of Glancullen and Ardinary, J.P., D.L., M.P. for Dublin co. 1832-37, and Clerk of the Hanaper Office of Ireland, a director of the National Bank, b. 1793; d. at Mascerata in the Roman States, on St. Christopher's Day, 25 July, 1856.
